

ORDINANCE NO. 82(2)

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REMOVAL OF SNOW AND ICE FROM SIDEWALKS INTENDED FOR PUBLIC USE AND THE PROCEDURE FOR REMOVAL IF THE PROPERTY OWNER FAILS TO DO SO.

The Town Board of the Town of Jefferson, Jefferson County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: The owner or occupant of real property shall remove snow and ice from sidewalks intended for public use within twenty-four hours after the end of a snowfall.

SECTION 2: The Town Chairman or his or her desinee my hire persons to clear sidewalks where owners or occupants have failed to do so within 24 hours. The Town Chairman or designee shall provide a statement of the cost of such removal to the Town Clerk.

SECTION 3: Unless paid within 30 days by the owner, the cost of such snow and ice removal shall be levied and collected as a special tax upon such lot or parcel by the owner thereof.

SECTION 4: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SECTION 5: EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.


The foregoing ordinance was adopted at a meeting of the Town Board of Jefferson, Jefferson County, Wisconsin, on the 6 day of November, 2000.






