97-07 TOWN OF JEFFERSON

ORDINANCE REGARDING THE IMPOSITION OF LATE FEES FOR ALL LICENSES

The Town Board of the Town of Jefferson, Jefferson County, Wisconsin, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN as follows:

SECTION 1: Effective with the date of passage and publication of this Ordinance according to law, the Town of Jefferson does hereby authorize the imposition of late fees for any licenses that are late according to the schedule adopted by State Statute or by the Town. The late fees shall be as set from time-to-time by the Town Board.

Presently a Ten Dollar (\$10.00) late fee is applied as to dog licenses. In addition, the late license holder shall also pay all postage costs, publication fee costs, and any other costs incurred by the Town.

SECTION 2: Regarding any liquor license, there shall be a late fee of ten percent (10%) of the total liquor license fee. If requested the proposed license holder shall make payment by cash, certified check, or cashier's check. If not paid by the date established by the Town, then payment shall be considered late and the license applicant shall be responsible for all costs associated with the late payment including but not necessarily limited to postage costs, publication fee costs, and any other costs incurred by the Town. If paid with an NSF check all NSF fees shall be paid by the license applicant. All licenses shall be picked up and paid for by the June Town Board meeting unless otherwise ordered by the Town. The late fee shall be assessed as of the date established by the Town Clerk or the Town Board. If not paid timely the late fee and all associated costs shall be placed on the real estate tax bill of the offending license seeker and if not paid shall be collected as a special charge and placed on the real estate tax bill.

SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY: The severable sections of this Ordinance are declared to be severable if any section or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful, or unenforceable. Such decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision, and shall not affect the validity of any other provisions, sections, or portions thereof of this ordinance. The remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Any other ordinances whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

This ordinance shall take effect EFFECTIVE DATE. SECTION 4: immediately upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.
