

**TOWN OF JEFFERSON****ORDINANCE # 99-07****REGULATING USE OF SKATEBOARDS, BICYCLES, IN-LINE SKATES,  
AND OTHER PLAY VEHICLES USED FOR NO LEGITIMATE PURPOSE**

The Town Board of the Town of Jefferson, Jefferson County, Wisconsin,  
DOES HEREBY ORDAIN as follows:

**SECTION 1:** No person shall operate or ride upon a skateboard, bicycle, in-line skates, scooter, or other play vehicle, within the Town of Jefferson in front of any public buildings in the Town of Jefferson and in particular in front of public buildings in Helenville, if said activity serves no legitimate purpose. Further, no person shall operate or ride upon a skateboard, bicycle, in-line skates, scooter, or other play vehicle on any sidewalk located adjacent to public buildings if said conduct serves no legitimate purpose:

- (1) in the Town of Jefferson;
- (2) in or on any other public property without the express permission of a person in authority at such place, or where the owner or person in charge of such property has posted signs at the entrance thereto that operation of such is prohibited; and
- (3) on any private property, parking lot, pedestrian way, or other premises without the express written permission of a person in authority at such place, or where the owner or person in charge of such property has posted signs at the entrance thereto that operation of such is prohibited.

**SECTION 2: PENALTIES:** Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof pay a forfeiture of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) together with the costs of prosecution.

**SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY:** The severable sections of this ordinance are declared to be severable if any section or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful, or unenforceable. Such decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision, and shall not affect the validity of any other provisions, sections, or portions thereof of this ordinance. The remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Any other ordinances whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

**SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.
