Medication & Prescription Disposal: Pills – Creams – Liquids – Prescriptions – Over the Counter Medications – Vitamins – Pet Medicines – Inhalers - <u>Drop-Off Locations</u>: Sheriff's jail lobby – Police Departments: Watertown, Lake Mills, Jefferson, Johnson Creek, Whitewater, Waterloo, Palmyra, UW-Whitewater and Fort Atkinson. Empty all pill type medications into a sandwich size bag; sealable bag - Keep liquids & ointments in original containers and place in plastic bags or tape the caps shut.
